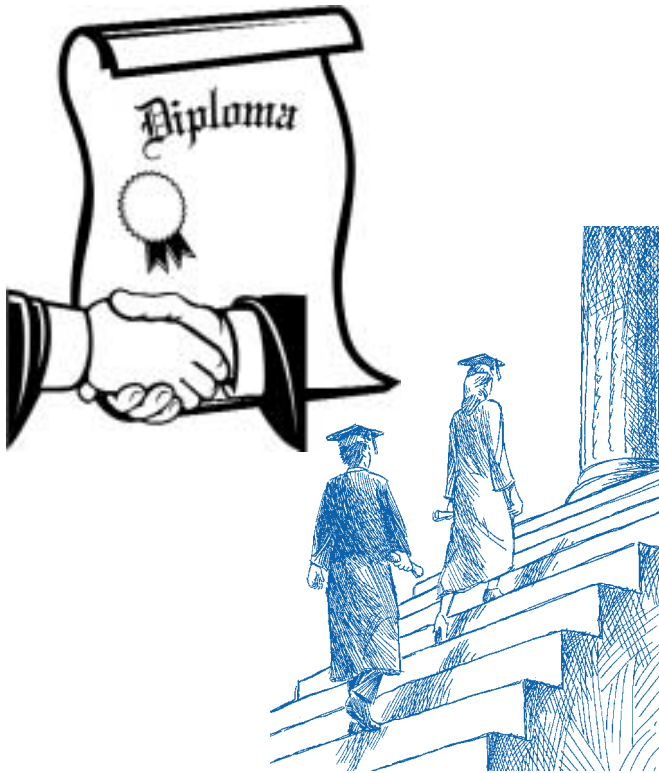

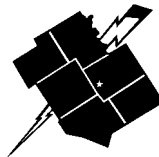

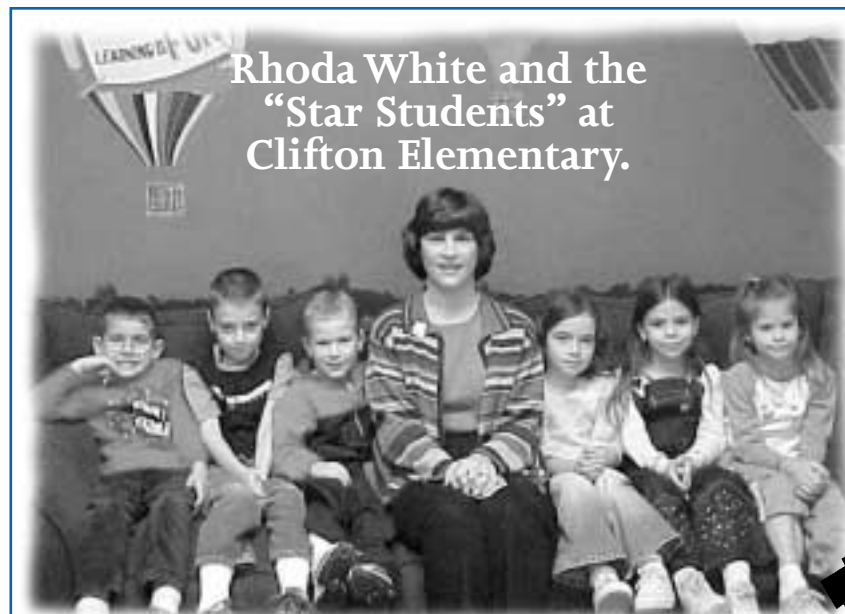

The Greene Family Camp is located just west of busy Interstate Highway 35 near Eddy. Beginning as an idea in the late 1960s, with construction started in 1974, its first use was in 1976 as a Jewish Synagogue Camp, similar to other church camps. It now also serves as a full-service retreat center for surrounding area communities, and serves the southwest region of the country as a special-needs facility for mentally and physically challenged campers.

Only half of the total 168 acres is currently being used for facilities, which include a chapel, campers' housing, three recreational halls, a theater, numerous workshop areas (for music, drama, dance and scouting), an arts and crafts building, two dining rooms, and a kitchen. Outdoor facilities include two pools; a large lake; areas for volleyball, basketball, soccer, football, softball and lighted tennis courts; challenge courses; mountain biking; and a petting zoo in the summer. The remaining acreage offers a rolling vista with open areas, a gazebo in a tree-lined area down a hillside, and plenty of room to explore the beauty of nature.



The number of visitors or campers depends on the season, but the camp has been designed for year-round use, as all indoor facilities are heated and air-conditioned. Average weekend attendance is 150 people; each of the 16 cabins will sleep 28. Private and semi-private accommodations are also available.

GREENE FAMILY CAMP



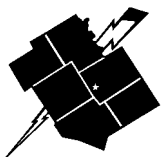
Greene Family Camp offers businesses and organizations the use of their Ropes Course, which is structured to have all group participants on an equal standing with one another, working together as a team to accomplish a task at hand. It requires learning to trust, being able to depend on each other for support, and promoting self-worth and accomplishment. The team is encouraged to complete a task using a unifying approach to solve problems.

McLennan County Electric is the electric provider for Greene Family Camp. When two co-op employees entered the security-gated area and arrived at the main camp office, they were invited into a relaxed and comfortable atmosphere. Camp Director Loui Dobin was awaiting the arrival of a new gym floor from Utah, which will be installed in one of the recreational halls. The home-like feeling is reinforced by two friendly dogs, who roam the hallway and offices. There is always something to be done, so the director and his staff keep busy overseeing daily maintenance. There are 16 full-time



staff members, an extra staff of 10 on weekends, and during summer camping periods, there are 150 additional counselors

helping with the campers. It is just like a small community where there is always something to do.
